The purpose of a retreat is to create an environment where Christian community may be experienced. The activities provide an enjoyable opportunity for the young people to develop a better sense of self, to build positive relationships with others, to deepen their understanding as a member of the Mullen Lasallian family, and to grow closer to God.

CODE OF CONDUCT

To accomplish the purpose of a retreat experience everyone on the retreat must agree to a 'Code of Conduct.' These guidelines are necessary to make the experience enjoyable for all and to avoid problems. Participants have a responsibility to themselves and others to follow these guidelines. All applicable student/parent handbook policies are in effect for Mullen High School retreats.

- Be Respectful and Safe.** At Mullen Retreats we expect to create an environment of safety and trust. The use of our bodies, language, and humor must always honor the dignity of every person. If you jeopardize the physical or emotional safety of yourself or the group, you choose to have parent or guardian pick you up and take you home immediately.
- Be Responsible and Honest.** Participants are expected to be present at all activities on time and participate fully. Established guidelines will be observed at all times. We need to take care of the retreat location. Any damage is to be reported immediately and involved persons are financially accountable. Emergencies that involve health and well being of people and/or property must be reported to adult staff immediately.
- Observe Appropriate Boundaries.** All participants must stay in the designated areas. Vehicles can only be used with specific permission from the retreat director and/or the Assistant Principal of Formation.
- Harmful Substances.** The use of illegal drugs, including alcohol, tobacco, or other illegal/harmful substances is not permitted. If you use these materials, you choose to have a parent and/or guardian pick you up and take you home immediately. Proper law enforcement authorities may be notified. Do not bring clothing that advertises/promotes alcohol, tobacco or drug use or anything displaying messages that are offensive or contain sexual innuendos. These are contrary to the values of our Lasallian Mission and are not acceptable at Mullen.
